COA AT A GLANCE

The Canadian Orientation Abroad (COA) programme has been providing pre-departure information and orientation sessions to refugees resettling to Canada since 1998.

The COA programme is a global initiative funded by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) and implemented by the IOM.

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) is a United Nations agency, the leading intergovernmental organization in the field of migration.

Migrant training activities are provided to approximately 60,000 migrants each year; for various receiving countries, including Canada, Australia, the U.S., the UK, and over 12 Member States in the European Economic Area and multiple Member States in Latin America.

Telephonic and virtual sessions during the COVID-19 pandemic (2-3 hours)



Refugees 13 years old and above



Support services available (childminding, interpretation, transportation, and lodging grant)







 15 COA PERMANENT SITES (many with regional coverage)


